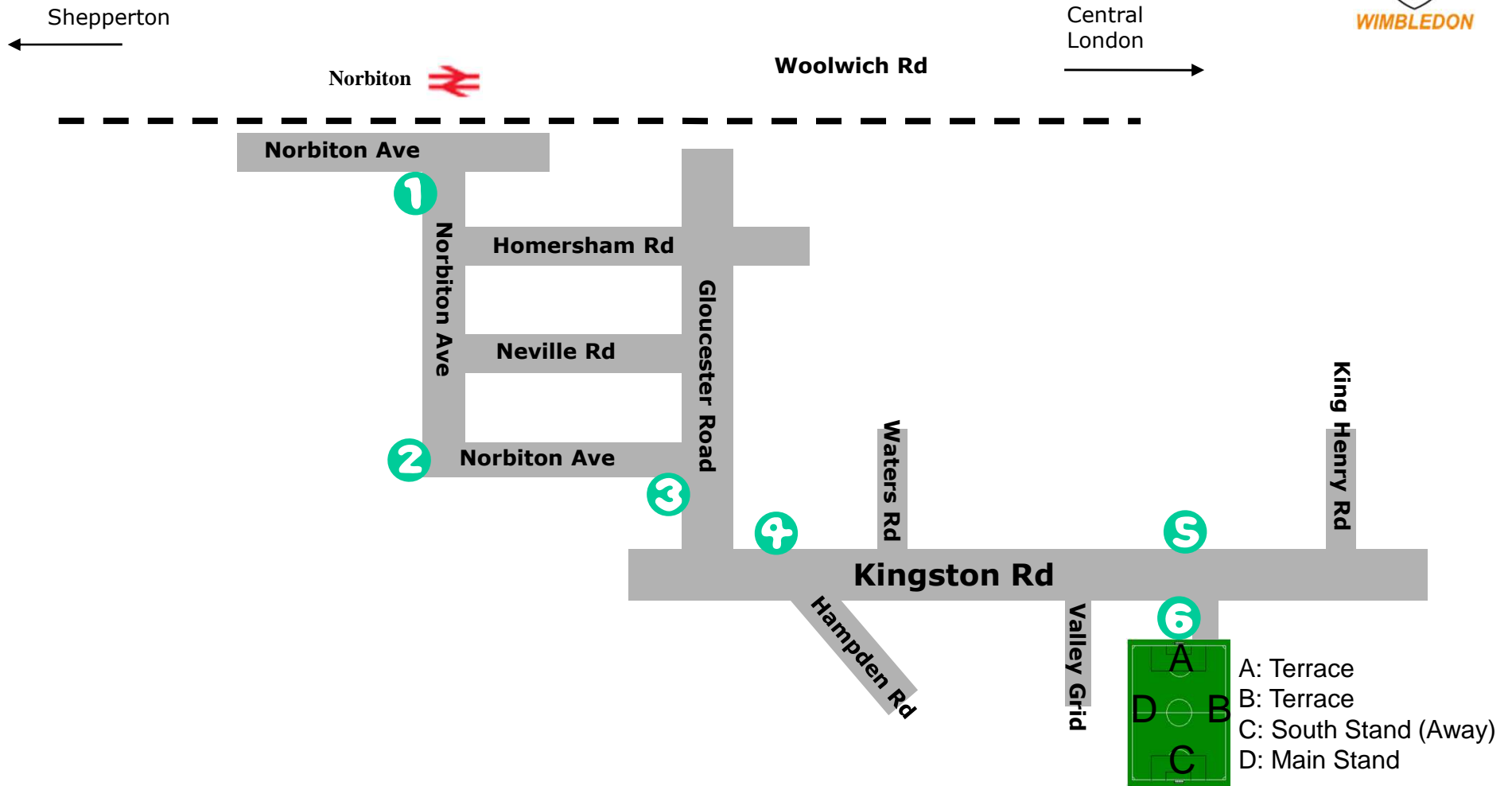

1. National Rail to NORBITON

Norbiton is served with trains from Waterloo. Leaving the station to the lefthand side in the direction of travel, just follow Noribton Avenue.



2. Follow Norbiton Avenue

Walk down Norbiton Avenue. The road will make a 90 degree turn to the left, just walk on.



3. Turn right into Gloucester Road

At the end of Norbiton Avenue, turn right into Gloucester Road.

4. Turn left into Kingston Road

After approx 150 meters turn left into Kingston Road..



5. Follow Kingston Road

Follow Kingston Road a few hundred meters. The ground is on your righthand side, there`s also a sign giving you directions.



6. Leave Kingston Road to righthand side

You can see the ground from Kingston Road already and you definitely won't miss the nice archway saying „Kingsmeadow“.

General Information:

Line: National Rail from Waterloo towards Shepperton

Travel time from Waterloo: about 25 minutes

Walking time from station to the ground: approx. 10 minutes

Alternative: Buses are running from „Morden“ (Northern Line), which call close to the ground. It will take you however more than 30 minutes on the bus.

After the final whistle: Due to the size of the ground, there are no problems going back to central London
