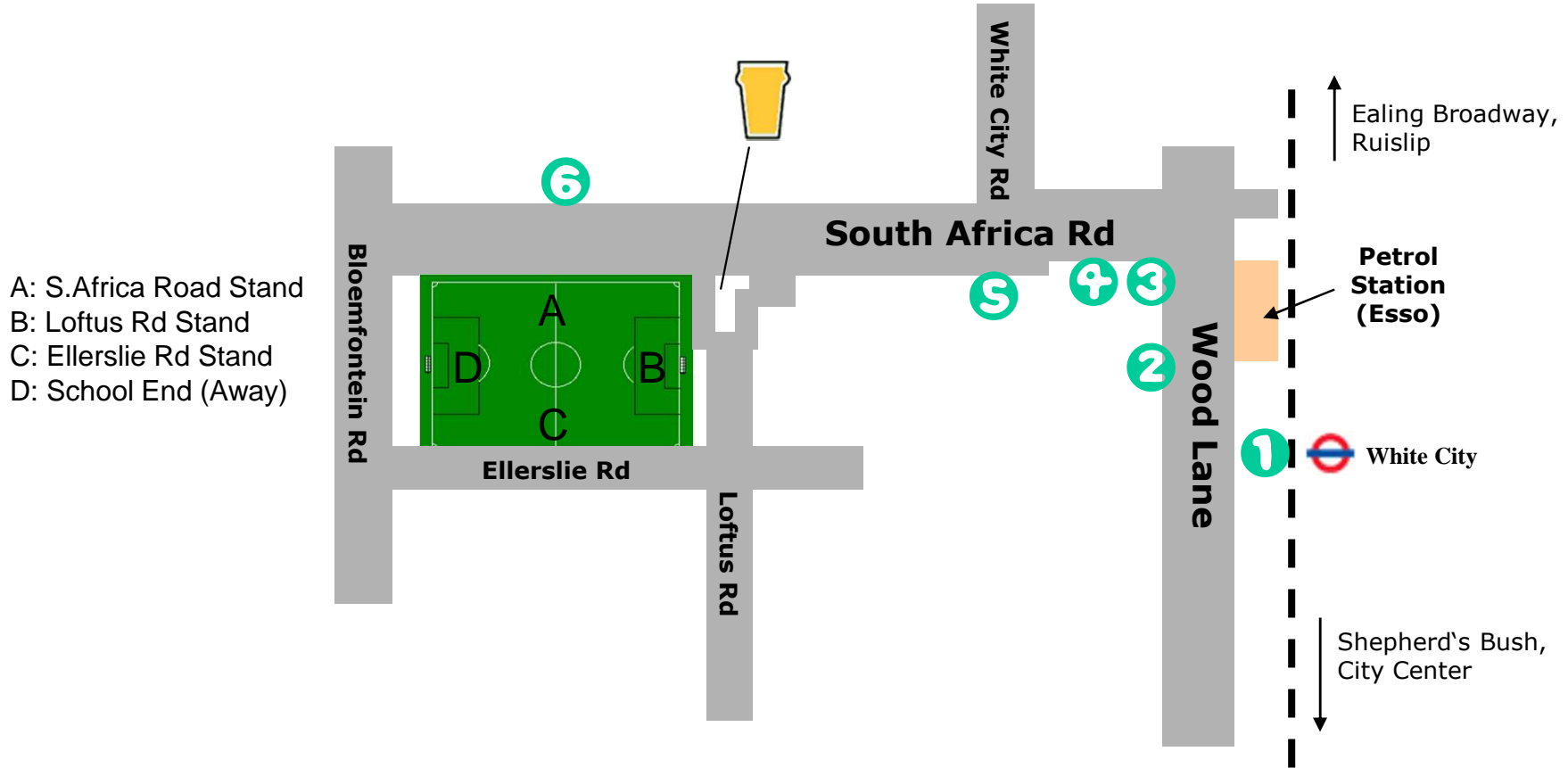


How to get to... Queens Park Rangers

How to get to... Queens Park Rangers South Africa Road, London, W12 7PA (Loftus Rd)



1. Central Line to WHITE CITY

Leave the station and immediately turn right, as signposted. It might be a good idea to cross the road at the traffic light right outside the station.

2. Follow Wood Lane to the first intersection

Just behind the petrol station on the righthand side, there's an intersection of Wood Lane and der South Africa Road.

3. Turn left into South Africa Road

That was the hard part. From now on, it's just walking.

4. Follow South Africa Road

Just keep on walking...



5. Stay on South Africa Road

South Africa Road bends a little bit at an intersection. Make sure you stay on South Africa Road, which will lead you past a training camp of the Territorial Army.



6. You've made it!

South Africa Road will get you right behind South Africa Road Stand. Not exactly a big surprise.

General Information

Line: Central Line to White City

Travel time from Tottenham Court Road: about 20 minutes

Walking time from station to the ground: a little bit more than 5 minutes

Alternatives: Shepherd's Bush on Hammersmith and City Line is also really close to the ground.

After the final whistle: As Loftus Road doesn't have a high capacity and the crowd spreads over two to three tube stations after the match, getting on the tube is actually pretty convenient.
